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## Responder's Rebids After Opener's NT Rebid Notes

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Opener's NT rebid narrowly defines their hand in both shape and strength.

### 1-minor – 1-Major – 1NT

- Corrective Bids
  - Bid Partner's minor at 2-level
  - 2-Major rebid
  - 1m – 1♠  
2NT - 2♥
- Jumps rebids 3-Level
- Jumps shifts to the 3-Level
- Responder's Reverse (at 2-Level)
- New Minor Forcing (NMF)
  - Follow-up Bids after NMF
  - *2-Way New Minor Forcing*
- Jumps to Game
- NT Bids
- Jumps to 4-Level in new suit

### 1♣ -- 1♦ -- 1NT

- Corrective Bids
  - 2♣
  - 2♦
- Jumps rebids 3-Level
- Jumps shifts to the 3-Level
- Responder's Reverse (at 2-Level)
- *2-Way New Minor Forcing*
- Jumps to Game
- NT Bids



## 1♥ -- 1♠ -- 1NT

- Corrective Bids
  - Bid Partner's minor at 2-level
  - 2-Major rebid
  - 1m – 1♠  
2NT - 2♥
- Jumps rebids 3-Level
- Jumps shifts to the 3-Level
- Responder's Reverse (at 2-Level)
- New Minor Forcing (NMF)
  - Follow-up Bids after NMF
  - *2-Way New Minor Forcing*
- Jumps to Game
- NT Bids
- Jumps to 4-Level in new suit

## 2NT Rebid by Opener

- Stop Below Game
- Look for the right game.
- Slam Try
  - Rebid
- New Minor Forcing
  - Wolff Signoff

## Competitive Bidding

- Opponents make a takeout double below 1NT.
- Opponents overcall below 1NT.
- Opponents bid above 1NT (after 1NT rebid).
